

# **GA7. Not Hardening Our Heart toward God.**

*We are not to harden our heart toward God.*

This precept is derived from His Word (blessed is He):

## **Comment**

Most often, when men do this it is because they do not like what they hear God saying or see what He is doing that affects them, and prefer to go their own way. It is the opposite of loving Him, trusting Him, and seeking his face.
