Feinberg, and "CY" refers to the "*Chayyei Yeshua* Three-Year *Besora* Reading Cycle" by Dr. Mark Kinzer.

Scripture chapters & verses appearing at the top of this chart are numbered according to the *Tanakh* (Hebrew) system adopted by the CJB. The Standard English versification is indicated in parentheses whenever there is a difference, and differences in the Ashkenaz and Sephardic *parashah* readings are indicated by (A) and (S) respectively. Also, (M) denotes CJB's recommendation for additional readings that have Messianic Jewish content. Chapters & verses of the *Tanakh* that appear in the right-hand column of this chart are numbered according to the Hebrew system only.
